**MOTION TO CORRECT DEFENDANT’S NAME**

COMES NOW the Plaintiff United States of America (“United States”) and moves the Court to issue its order correcting the name of the defendant specified below to read as follows:

In support of this motion, the United States asserts that the defendant in question has returned a waiver of service of summons (filed October 20, 2006, Doc. No. 848) on which both her signature and hand-printed name indicate her first name is spelled “Debra.” The corrected name is otherwise so phonetically and orthographically similar that there can be no reasonable question that the corrected name represents the same person.

WHEREFORE, the United States moves the Court to enter an order correcting the defendant's name "DEBORAH LEE OLIVER" to "DEBRA LEE OLIVER."
