and as grounds therefor Plaintiffs state:

1. The Court has jurisdiction over the above-named defendants as shown by the filed waiver of service of summons of MARY N. HAAG (Doc. No. 875) and RICHARD G. HAAG (Doc. No. 875).

2. MARY N. HAAG & RICHARD G. HAAG were provided the documents

listed in the Declaration of Gary A. Durr (Exhibit 1) on the dates indicated.

3. With respect to Subfile ZRB-4-0171, Defendants MARY N. HAAG &

RICHARD G. HAAG were subject to the Special Master's September 28, 2006 Procedural and

Scheduling Order for the Adjudication of Water Rights Claims in Sub-Areas 1, 2, and 3

(Excluding Ramah) of the Zuni River Stream System (Doc. No. 838)("Procedural and Scheduling

Order"), which established a deadline of January 15, 2007 for the submission of a Request for

Consultation or the return of a signed Consent Order.

These deadlines for Subfile ZRB-4-0171 were never extended. 4.
