granting default judgment against the following defendants:

and as grounds therefor Plaintiffs state:

1. The Court has jurisdiction over the above-named defendants as shown by

the filed service of summons on REBEKAH ANAST (Doc. No. 1860) and GABE ANAST (Doc. No. 1860).

2. REBEKAH ANAST & GABE ANAST were provided the documents listed in the Declaration of Gary A. Durr (Exhibit 1) on the dates indicated.

3. With respect to Subfile ZRB-4-0260, Defendants REBEKAH ANAST & GABE ANAST were subject to the Special Master's September 28, 2006 *Procedural and Scheduling Order for the Adjudication of Water Rights Claims in Sub-Areas 1, 2, and 3* (*Excluding Ramah*) *of the Zuni River Stream System* (Doc. No. 838)("Procedural and Scheduling Order"), which established a deadline of December 9, 2008 for the submission of a Request for Consultation or the return of a signed Consent Order.

4. These deadlines for Subfile ZRB-4-0260 were never extended.

5.
