and as grounds therefor Plaintiffs state:

1. The Court has jurisdiction over the above-named defendants as shown by the filed waiver of service of summons of TIMOTHY L. ZAHN (Doc. No. 958) and ARLENE DOWERS (Doc. No. 962).

- 2. TIMOTHY L. ZAHN & ARLENE DOWERS were provided the documents listed in the Declaration of Gary A. Durr (Exhibit 1) on the dates indicated.
- 3. With respect to Subfile ZRB-4-0427, Defendants TIMOTHY L. ZAHN & ARLENE DOWERS were subject to the Special Master's September 28, 2006 Procedural and Scheduling Order for the Adjudication of Water Rights Claims in Sub-Areas 1, 2, and 3 (Excluding Ramah) of the Zuni River Stream System (Doc. No. 838)("Procedural and Scheduling Order"), which established a deadline of January 19, 2007 for the submission of a Request for Consultation or the return of a signed Consent Order.
  - These deadlines for Subfile ZRB-4-0427 were never extended. 4.
- 5. Defendants TIMOTHY L.
