## **MOTION FOR DEFAULT JUDGMENT**

1. The Court has jurisdiction over the above-named defendants as shown by the filed Proof of Service of Process by Publication (Doc. No.2379).

- 2. EVELYN BRADFORD & DAVID BRADFORD were provided the documents listed in the Declaration of Khaleelah E. Jones (Exhibit 1) on the dates indicated.
- 3. With respect to Subfile ZRB-1-0131, Defendants EVELYN BRADFORD & DAVID BRADFORD were subject to the Special Master's September 8, 2005 Amended Procedural and Scheduling Order for the Adjudication of Water Rights Claims in Sub-Areas 4 and 8 of the Zuni River Stream System (Doc. No. 387) ("Procedural and Scheduling Order"), which established a deadline of January 10, 2006 for the submission of a Request for Consultation or the return of a signed Consent Order.
