MOTION FOR DEFAULT JUDGMENT

1. The Court has jurisdiction over the above-named defendant as shown by the filed Proof of Service of Process by Publication (Doc. No. 2379).

- 2. R.W. ADER was provided the documents listed in the Declaration of Khaleelah E. Jones (Exhibit 1) on the dates indicated.
- 3. With respect to Subfile ZRB-4-0024, Defendant R.W. ADER is subject to the Special Master's September 28, 2006 Procedural and Scheduling Order for the Adjudication of Water Rights Claims in Sub-Areas 1, 2, and 3 (Excluding Ramah) of the Zuni River Stream System (Doc. No. 838) ("Procedural and Scheduling Order"), which established a deadline of sixty days after delivery of a service packet for the submission of a Request for Consultation or the return of a signed Consent Order.
- 4. These deadlines for Subfile ZRB-4-0024 were never extended. In addition, Defendant R.W. ADER failed to appear and defend in this case by June 30, 2009, as required by the Court-approved *Notice of Lawsuit and Summons* served on the Defendant by Publication.
- 5. Defendant R.W.
