### **MOTION FOR DEFAULT JUDGMENT**

The Plaintiffs United States of America ("United States") and New Mexico ex rel. State Engineer ("State"), pursuant to Fed. R. Civ P. 55(b)(2), move the Court to enter its order granting default judgment against the following defendants:

and as grounds therefor Plaintiffs state:

1. The Court has jurisdiction over the above-named defendants as shown by the filed service of summons on MARCIA LAMBSON (Doc. No. 1852) and PRESTON LAMBSON (Doc. No. 1852)

2. MARCIA LAMBSON & PRESTON LAMBSON were provided the documents listed in the Declaration of Khaleelah E. Jones (Exhibit 1) on the dates indicated.

3. With respect to Subfile ZRB-4-0226, Defendants MARCIA LAMBSON & PRESTON LAMBSON were subject to the Special Master's September 28, 2006 *Procedural and Scheduling Order for the Adjudication of Water Rights Claims in Sub-Areas 1, 2, and 3* (*Excluding Ramah*) of the Zuni River Stream System (Doc. No. 838)("Procedural and Scheduling Order"), which established a deadline of January 16, 2007 for the submission of a Request for Consultation or the return of a signed Consent Order.

- 4. These deadlines for Subfile ZRB-4-0226 were never extended.
- 5. Defendants MARCIA LAMBSON & PRESTON LAMBSON are in default for failure to appear, answer, or otherwise defend in Subfile ZRB-4-0226 within the time limitations imposed by the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, applicable Procedural and Scheduling Orders, or Orders of the Court extending deadlines, as shown by the Clerk's Certificate of Default filed February 5, 2009 (Doc. No. 2097).
