

You are decreasing to .7 ac-ft which may only be adequate for a small family of 4 or 5 inside only. The ability to raise any livestock or have a garden may be impossible. I feel that this is taking away rights that we have paid and worked for. Definitely Not The American Way. I also do not believe your assessment of usage.

I (We) made a good faith effort to resolve my (our) disagreement with the Consent Order

proposed by the United States and the State by:  
I was only able to talk by phone because of the time that was allotted. The phone conversation was only one-sided. There was no conversation over my objections. They only said what they were going to do. When I brought up that I felt what was being done was so they would have a low amount and when they decide to put water meters on, the allotment would be low and most people would go over the allotment. At that point, they almost hung up, it was a quick goodbye. They were not concerned with what I had to say. A complete waste of my time.



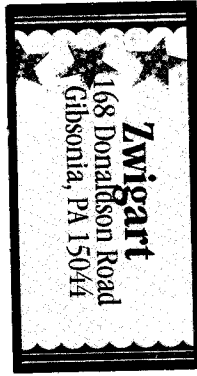
