JOINT STATUS REPORT CONCERNING PROGRESS OF NEGOTIATIONS

The State of New Mexico *ex rel*. State Engineer ("State"), the United States of America ("United States"), the Zuni Indian Tribe ("Zuni"), and the Navajo Nation ("Navajo") (collectively, the "Parties"), through undersigned counsel, jointly submit this Status Report to the Court pursuant to its December 10, 2013 *Order Vacating Scheduling Orders and Directing Submission of Status Report* [Doc. 333].

- 1. The State, the United States, and Zuni met several times during the past six months to frame issues and identify tasks to best pursue settlement discussions.
- 2. Based on these initial discussions, the State, the United States, and Zuni agreed settlement negotiations would benefit from development of certain technical information and formed a technical subcommittee for that purpose. The State, the United States, and Zuni determined it was prudent to engage the Navajo Nation in the work of the technical committee, and Navajo has since joined the technical subcommittee.

3. The Parties' technical subcommittee has conferred on several occasions, including

meetings on February 24, 2014 and May 15, 2014, and is initiating work on a hydrologic model

to be used to facilitate settlement discussions.

4. Counsel for the Parties have drafted a Negotiation Process and Confidentiality

Agreement governing settlement discussions which counsel expect to finalize in the near future.

The Parties jointly agree more time is necessary to determine whether these 5.

negotiations will prove fruitful. Therefore, the Parties propose to continue settlement discussions

and related technical work for an additional six months and to provide the Court with a second

Status Report on the progress of negotiations six months from the date of filing this Status

Report.
